Two-Story Broadcast Center

Temporary Office Space



Triumph Modular installed a two-story, ten-module, 7,200 sq ft broadcast center for the US Open. The center was designed to house major sports television broadcasters. Logistics were an essential consideration due to city ordinances, traffic and construction, and the need to complete the installation quickly due to a very compressed schedule. Custom fabricated exterior stairs and decking with a covered metal canopy were installed for occupant access and equipment installation. Interior demountable partitions for ease of disassembly and storage upon event completion.

While the building is designed for quick installation and easy removal every year for the US Open, the design also allows the building to be winterized for use year-round. The modular installation allowed for changeable layouts based on occupant needs. The partitions were designed to include a sliding pocket door capable of being placed at various or multiple locations within the mobile units. Occupancy sensors were installed throughout the modular units. Additional insulation was used with heavy-duty HVAC units to keep the building cool and offset the considerable heat emitted from the broadcasting equipment. High-efficiency, dual electrical panels were installed with backup emergency power.
