# Temporary Education Space

Project Additional Classrooms



Thayer Academy is a prestigious preparatory school south of Boston, Massachusetts. The COVID-19 pandemic necessitated the expansion of their learning space to accommodate social distancing protocols. Thayer Academy joined forces with Triumph Modular and our factory partner, Whitley Manufacturing, to create three additional classrooms.

The five Silverline modular units were rapidly deployed and ready to use within days with minimal disruption to the school campus. Using two modular units per classroom created an oversized space and included an ADA-compliant ramp for easy access. Aluminum decking connected two of the modular classrooms.

The Silverline buildings feature large energy-efficient windows that optimize sunlight and ventilation. These units feature a contemporary design with galvalume metal siding, exposed duct work, a visible ceiling deck with open webbing, and durable LVT flooring. Also included are occupancy sensors and LED bulbs for lighting that are code compliant for energy efficiency.
